

RESOLUTION 104-16

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT TO SELL PROPERTY UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES VIA INTERNET AUCTION

WHEREAS, the City has certain property that is unneeded, obsolete or unfit for municipal purposes;
and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code § 721.15 permits such property to be sold via internet auction; and

WHEREAS, such statute requires the enactment of a resolution expressing its intent to sell such property by internet auction.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

The City intends to sell the following property via internet auction:

- (A) 2008 Chevrolet Impala VIN/2G1WS583289173545
- (B) 2008 Chevrolet Impala VIN/2G1WS583089176640
- (C) 2004 GMC Yukon VIN/1GKEK13ZX4J137516
- (D) 2002 Harley Road King, VIN/1HD1FHW152Y614370

SECTION II:

- (A) The auction(s) will be conducted through online competitive bidding, with a reserve to be determined;
- (B) The number of days for bidding shall be ten (10) days including weekends and legal holidays;
- (C) The City will contract with a representative to conduct the auction, which representative is not known at this time; and
- (D) The item will be sold under the following terms and conditions:
 - (1) the property will be sold to the bidder submitting the highest and best bid that meets the specified reserve, if any;
 - (2) the sale shall be completed for cash by cashier's check or other certified funds;
 - (3) pick-up, delivery or shipping shall be the sole responsibility of the buyer;
 - (4) sales tax, if any, shall be the sole responsibility of the buyer; and
 - (5) subject to any and all rules and regulations established by the auction representative.

SECTION III:

The Clerk of this Council shall publish, at least twice and in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, notice of the passage of this resolution, including a summary of the information provided in the resolution. The second and any subsequent notice must be published at least ten (10) but not more than twenty (20) days after the previous notice.

SECTION IV:

The City shall also continually post the notice throughout the calendar year in a conspicuous place in the following places:

- (A) the office of the City Auditor;
- (B) the offices of City Council; and
- (C) on the City’s website.

SECTION V:

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
