A RESOLUTION CREATING THE CITY PROPERTIES COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City of London owns various real properties including buildings and vacant land; and

WHEREAS, the properties are in need of an established committee to examine the function, condition, finances, and use of the City's real properties, including the purchase and sale of real property, and make recommendations to Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

There is hereby established City Properties Committee for the City of London. The Committee shall examine the function, condition, finances, and use of City's real properties, including the purchase and sale of real property, and make recommendations to Council.

The Committee shall be comprised of five members. Two of its members shall be current members of London City Council. Two of its members shall be residents of the City of London. The final member shall be an employee of the City. The Mayor shall appoint members to the Committee, subject to Council's approval. The members shall serve without compensation.

Two terms shall end on December 31, 2016. Three terms shall end on December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the terms shall be for two years. Two of the three Committee members whose terms end on December 31, 2017, shall be members of London City Council and their terms will coincide with their terms on Council.

SECTION II:

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
