**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RETIRED TAXPAYERS EXEMPT FROM MUNICIPAL INCOME
TAX RELIEF FROM MANDATORY FILING OF RETURNS**

WHEREAS, Section 881.091 of the City of London Codified Ordinances (“LCO”) requires that each resident of the City complete and file a municipal income tax return each year; and

WHEREAS, there are many people who are exempt from municipal income tax under Chapter 881 of the LCO pursuant to the exemption contained in Section 881.03(11)(C) of LCO; and

WHEREAS, the Income Tax Department of the City wishes to relieve those that have only exempt income from the mandatory duty to file municipal income tax returns pursuant to 881.091 of the LCO.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE
OF OHIO**

SECTION I:

Any residents of the City that complete the form attached hereto as Exhibit A to the satisfaction of the Income Tax Department are hereby exempt from the requirements to file a return pursuant to Section 881.091 of the LCO

SECTION II:

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
