**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT FOR THE DEMOLITION OF PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the City has issued an order declaring the property located at 16 East High Street unsafe and dangerous, and ordering that it shall be abated by construction or demolition; and

WHEREAS, the property owner neither appealed the order to the Board of Building Appeals nor to the Madison County Common Pleas Court; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested bids for the demolition and is in position to award the contract to the lowest and best bidder.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE
OF OHIO**

SECTION I:

The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for demolition in an amount not to exceed twenty two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500.00) for the demolition

SECTION II:

That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation and protection of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of London for the reason that the property constitutes a real and present danger of collapsing, and therefore, shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor.
