A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities has decided to construct a water treatment plant to enhance the water delivery system of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Utilities advertised for bids for the project, received bids for the project, reviewed those bids and has selected the lowest and best bid among those received; and

WHEREAS, due to the amount of the contract, this Council must authorize the contract pursuant to Section 278.06(c) of the Codified Ordinances of London.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

The Board of Public Utilities is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the construction of the water treatment plant.

SECTION II: the contract shall not exceed six million one hundred twenty thousand and sixty five dollars (\$6,120,065.00) plus a five percent (5%) contingency.

SECTION III:

That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare. Due to the application coming before the Ohio Water Development Authority on March 31, 2016 for approval. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
