AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016

WHEREAS, the City of London’s Finance Committee has voted to recommend an appropriation increase in the City’s various departments Capital funds in support of specific capital needs; AND

WHEREAS, the available funds cannot be expended until there is sufficient appropriation in the fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of London, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016, the following sums to be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, to wit:

That there be appropriated from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Fund to:

Fire Department	Fund 229	\$110,000.00
Recreation Department	Fund 237	\$25,000.00
Street Department	Fund 242	\$366,000.00
Total		\$612,000.00

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
