

AMENDED RESOLUTION 135-18

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of London has an existing 3 mill levy for the Madison County Emergency Medical District; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to place a 2 mill levy on the ballot for the City of London Fire and Emergency Services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION I:

That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the General Operating Levy at the maximum rate authorized by R.C. Section 5705.02 on the taxable property in the City of London will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for necessary requirements of said City and it is necessary for the purpose of providing additional funds for current expenses be levied for the period of five years at a rate in excess of such a maximum rate authorized by said R.C. Section 5705.02.

SECTION II:

That it is necessary to levy taxes for the duplicate years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 commencing calendar year 2018 at the rate for each year of 2 mills on each dollar of the tax valuation of the taxable property within the City of London in excess of the rate authorized by said R.C. Section 5705.02.

SECTION III:

In anticipation of the necessity to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation, and in accordance with R.C. 5705.03, the City of London requests the Madison County Auditor to certify the total current tax valuation of the subdivision, and specific amount of revenue, or the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specific number of mills.

SECTION IV:

The specific dollar amount to be generated by such levy is 2 mills, the purpose of such levy is to provide fire and emergency services to the City of London, such levy would be an additional tax to be submitted to the voters under R.C. 5705.03 on November 6, 2018.

SECTION V:

That the Clerk of this Council be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Madison County, Ohio in order that said Board of Elections of Madison County, Ohio, may take necessary arrangements for the submissions of such questions to the electors of said City as provided by law, and there is a City-Wide Election.

SECTION IV:

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
