**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NON-COLLECTION OF THE 3 MILL
LEVY FOR THE MADISON COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the voters of the City have previously approved a 3 mill property tax levy for the purpose of the Madison County Emergency Medical District; and

WHEREAS, this Council has proposed a 2 mill Fire Property Tax Levy to be placed on the ballot for the purpose of the City of London Fire and Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, if the 2 mil property tax levy passes the 3 mill property tax levy will no longer be necessary.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONDON, STATE OF OHIO**

SECTION I:

If the property tax levy passes in November, 2018, the County Budget Commission is hereby requested to not collect the property tax of 3 mills for the purpose of the Madison County Emergency Medical District such that the City will not receive any money from the levy on or after January 1, 2019.

SECTION II:

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
