

**CITY OF LONDON  
APPLICATIONS AND CIVIL SERVICE  
EXAMINATIONS FOR FIREFIGHTER**

The City of London, Ohio will be accepting applications and conducting civil service examinations for the position of **FIREFIGHTER**. Applicants must meet minimum qualifications to be considered for the examination. An applicant meeting minimum qualifications must be at least 18 years of age, in good physical condition, possess a High school diploma or equivalent, possess a valid driver's license, and possess State of Ohio Firefighter I & II and Emergency Medical Technician Certifications. Applicants are required to pass a physical agility test, background check, drug screen and a physical examination prior to employment. The City of London is an equal opportunity employer offering a starting salary range of \$17.91 to \$21.79 per hour for firefighter/EMT and \$18.86 to \$ 22.87 per hour for firefighter/paramedic, uniform allowance, paid vacation after the first year, personal days, health insurance, educational allowance and other benefits per bargaining unit contract.

The following adjustments shall be made to the score of applicants on the condition that they pass the entry level examination with a score in all sections of 70% or greater. Additional credit shall be awarded to a maximum of 30% of the raw score. The London Civil Service Commission will not accept documentation for credit unless received by 4pm on May 6, 2019 at London City Hall located at 20 South Walnut Street, London, Ohio 43140.

1. **Veteran's credit** – 20% additional credit shall be granted to Ohio residents who are honorably discharged from the United States Armed Forces. (Must submit copy of DD214, including block 24 at time of filing).
2. **Education credit** – 10% maximum credit for a Bachelor's Degree from a North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCACS) accredited college or university. 5% credit for an Associate's Degree from a North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCACS) accredited college or university. A maximum of 10% will be given and the applicant must submit a copy of Diploma at the time of filing.
3. **Training credit** – 20% maximum 10% additional credit shall be awarded for Advanced Emergency Medical Technician. 20% additional credit shall be awarded for Paramedic. Applicants must submit a copy of their current certification at time of filing that includes the certification dates. An applicant will not receive training credit if the CSC is unable to determine the certification dates from the submitted documentation.

City of London Applications must be completed and hand signed, and must be received by 4pm on May 6, 2019 at London City Hall. Applications can be picked up at City Hall

at 20 South Walnut Street, London, OH 43140. To receive an application in PDF format, email [Firechief@ci.london.us](mailto:Firechief@ci.london.us). The applications will be reviewed by the London CSC at their regular meeting on May 8, 2019 at 4:15pm.

The examination will be provided by I/O Solutions and administered by the London Civil Service Commission on **May 18, 2019** at London City Hall, 20 South Walnut Street, London, Ohio 43140. The doors will open at 8:30am and the examination will begin at 9:00am.

If you wish to file an appeal to the London Civil Service Commission, a written appeal must be received at London City Hall no later than ten (10) days after the final date of testing by 4pm. All appeals will be considered at the regularly scheduled CSC meeting following the testing period on June 12, 2019 at 4:15pm.

Those applicants meeting the minimum qualifications for the position, and receiving a passing score on the examination, will be considered for eligibility. Once appeals have been considered and ruled upon by the CSC at the June 12, 2019 meeting, a final list will be posted at London City Hall and at [www.ci.london.oh.us](http://www.ci.london.oh.us).
