

NOTICE FOR BID

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Public Utilities of the City of London, Ohio, State of Ohio at the office of said board, 100 South Main Street, London, Ohio, until 10:00 A.M. on Monday, April 30, 2018. For the repair/addition of the sanitation maintenance building located at the trash transfer plant at 233 Jenkinson Ave., London, and Ohio. Each bid must contain the full name of every person or company interested. The bid must also show a date and a competition time line. The building is occupied and in use, so work must be done around normal work procedures and premises must be secured at all times.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond or a certified or cashier check in the amount of 10% of the bid amount (no cash) as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into.

Upon entering into a contract, the successful bidder shall furnish a contract performance bond in the amount of 100% of the bid, to the satisfaction of said Board of Public Utilities, and on doing so, said certified or cashier check shall be returned to the successful bidder.

All bidders must also show insurance liability of \$1 million each occurrence and \$2 million general aggregate, show the City of London as an additional insured and provide the appropriate certificate of insurance to said Board of Public Utilities.

Approved and stamped plans for said repair/addition are located at the sanitation maintenance office located at 233 Jenkinson Ave., London, Oh.
